BLOOM AGAIN FOUNDATION HELD 'DRINK LOCAL: A TOAST TO SUMMER'S END'

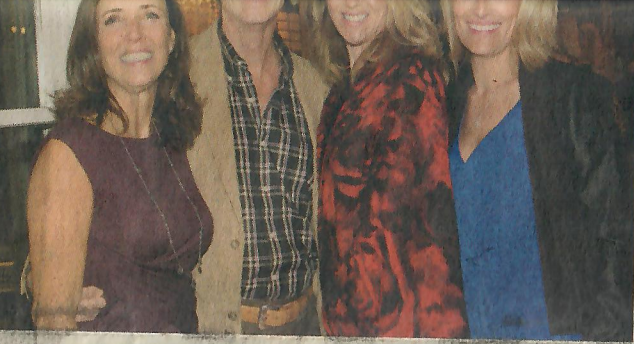

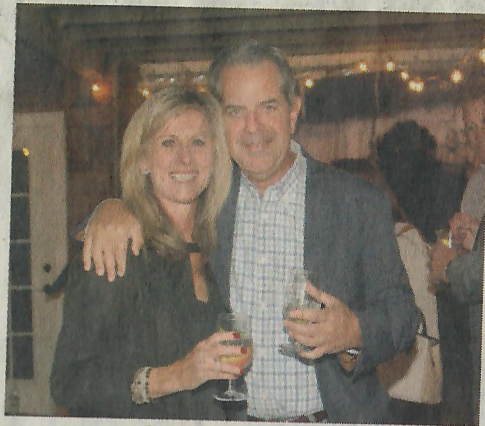
